AB	b2b	Border to Border (designed to fit within borders with minimal unquilted spaces at the edges.)
AB	e2e	Edge to Edge pattern (designed to cover the whole quilt.)
AB	L corner	L-shaped corner, more than just a corner block, it connects the pattern coming into and going out of the corner.
AS	BG	Background
AS	Fill	Designed to fill in background with minimal amount of retracing or tie-offs
AS	Trim BG	Trim Background (Stitches up to a line and then re-trace back)
KD	ALT	Alternating
KD	BA	Baltimore Album
